With Brexit now underway and the UK officially leaving the European Union, the process of withdrawal has begun. The Queen's Speech in June reflected the opportunity ahead for the UK and included: A Repeal Bill to provide legal certainty as we leave; an Immigration Bill giving us control over the number of people coming here from Europe; a Trade Bill and a

new Customs Bill to enable the UK to conduct its own independent Trade policy, helping British businesses trade with thriving global markets; a Fisheries Bill and an Agriculture Bill. As head of the European Research Group [ERG], I want to ensure the group plays a vital role in making a prosperous Brexit a reality.
