T Levels

The Government has announced that new T Levels will be delivered from September 2020 for young people. The qualifications are a vocational alternative to A levels, and will take effect in England, covering subjects which include childcare, construction, education, engineering and manufacturing. I am very pleased that Fareham College has been selected as one of the providers. The College is already an outstanding place to learn. This announcement means that many more Fareham students will benefit from a higher level of skills and improved career prospects.



Security after Brexit

I met with my EU counterparts in Croatia and the Czech Republic to discuss our future security partnership after we leave the EU: how the UK plans to work with the EU on our internal and external security including cross-border law enforcement, exchange of data, sanctions and Galileo. It's clear that our contribution to security and counter-terrorism is valued across the EU and we will continue to work closely with our European allies after Brexit.

IFA2 and Chilling Lane Substation

I met the teams responsible for IFA2 and Chilling Lane substation, to learn more about how the sites are developing. I also visited the substation site on Chilling Lane where National Grid provided an update on progress both with the substation and the cable works. The interconnector, IFA2 is a significant project for the UK and will help support our energy demands. It needs to be completed in 2019, so I am pleased to see progress is being made.



Hook-with-Warsash CoE Academy

I visited Hook-with-Warsash CoE Academy where I met with Headteacher Sara Willoughby, the teaching staff and school Governors Roger Clear and Rev Mike Terry of St Mary's Church in Warsash, to discuss raising funding for the school. I took assembly, with a Q&A, where pupils were able to quiz me on Brexit, life as an MP, laws and democracy, votes for children and inspiring role models. It's good to see the school doing so well!
